### Liberal Hypocrisy on Immigration

The Liberal party of Canada continues their hypocrisy on immigration with claims that proposed legislation to improve Canada's immigration system will close the door on potential newcomers.

"The fact is it was the Liberals who slammed the door shut on thousands of potential new Canadians when they allowed the backlog to grow from 50,000 applications when they took office in 1993 to 900,000 applications today," stated Ed Komarnicki, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Immigration and Citizenship. "Our Conservative government values the contribution newcomers have made in building this great country. That's why we are proposing to modernize Canada's immigration system: Lowering the bloated Liberal backlog will allow families to be reunited faster and labour market demands to be met."

On May 27, St. Paul's Conservatives will elect 10 delegates to attend the Conservative Party's national convention. This is our opportunity to update the Party's policy platform and reflect the values of our members.

The national convention will be held in Winnipeg from November 13-15, 2008. The convention will continue the grass-roots policy development process that was launched at the first convention in March, 2005. St. Paul's Conservative EDA has contributed to that process with formal policy meetings in December, 2006 and February, 2008.

In order to participate at the Delegate Selection Meeting (DSM), you must be a Party member as of May 6—twenty-one (21) days prior to the meeting. You are also required to produce two (2) pieces of identification. At least one piece of identification must include your photo and residential address.

To stand as a delegate, you are required to be a resident of St. Paul's and have been a member of the Party at least ninety (90) days prior to May 27. Non-resident members of the EDA Board are also eligible to stand as delegates. One delegate must be 23 years of age or younger as of November 15, 2008.

**If you would like to stand as a delegate you must complete the enclosed Delegate Candidate form. The form must contain with the name, address, and signature of both a Mover and Seconder who are eligible to vote at the DSM. Candidates that submit their form to me prior to 7:30 PM on May 27 will be on the ballot.** You can give me your completed form during the registration period on May 27 if you wish. Complete rules governing DSMs are available at the Party web site [www.conservative.ca](http://www.conservative.ca). Feel free to call me if you have any questions.

This is an exciting time to be a Conservative and St. Paul's has a tradition of national leadership within our Party. Let's ensure we continue that legacy by sending a strong delegation to Winnipeg!

## Liberal immigration hypocrisy

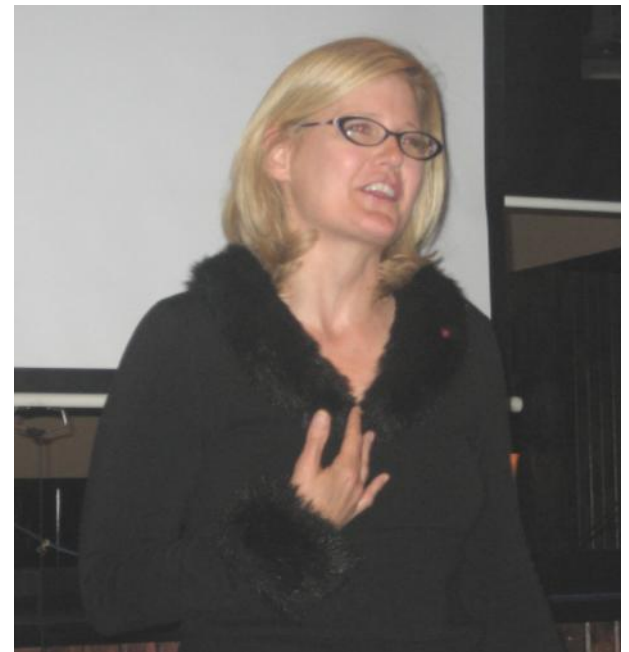
